Policy on the interment of cremated remains

- Cremated remains may only be interred in the designated area. This designated area is a border in the Southern part of the Eastern boundary of the church yard.
- Cremated remains only may be interred for reasons of symbolism and practicality. (I.e. no urns or containers may be put in the ground.)
- A stone in memory of the deceased may be laid over the cremated remains. It must be of dimensions: 10" x 10" and 1" deep and made of natural unpolished stone.
- Inscriptions should be in plain text with the name first, dates second and any statements last.
- An application from the monumental mason with a design for the stone and the inscription must be submitted to the incumbent, or in the case of a vacancy, the wardens, for approval before the stone is installed.
